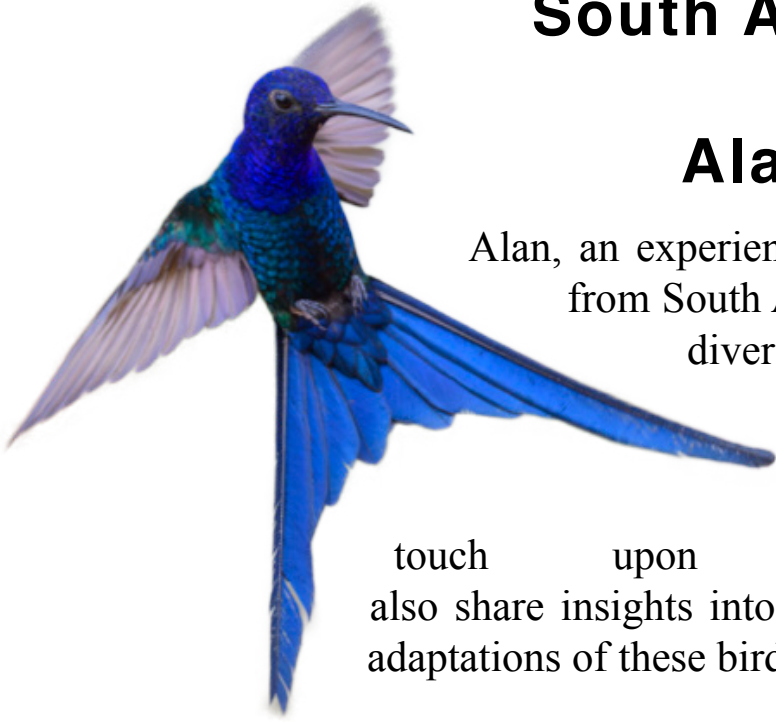


South America - Birds and Birding
